
LONGVIEW BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

FACT SHEET

ABOUT THE PROJECT

This project will analyze and recommend the best location for a sidewalk on Longview Boulevard between Taylor Avenue and Woodlawn Avenue and between Longview Boulevard and Woodlawn Avenue on East Essex Avenue. The project will also include resurfacing and restriping Longview Boulevard.

Residents and city leaders recognize the need for sidewalks to support safe and comfortable walking. Kirkwood's Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan, adopted in 2015, identified the need for a sidewalk connecting Longview Boulevard to sidewalks on Taylor and Woodlawn Avenues.

SCHEDULE, PROJECT DESIGN



EARLY SUMMER: Engage the Community/Conduct Initial Survey Work

- Inform property owners and stakeholders of potential changes on Longview
- Public meeting and community survey on preferred location and features
- initial survey work.

In June, residents will notice staff from engineering firm TWM in yards and on the street marking utilities with paint and flags and pagraphic data. Resident

MID-SUMMER: Develop Recommendations

- © Complete topographic survey
- Use community input to determine sidewalk location and prioritize features
- Develop traffic calming plan
- Settle right-of-way with impacted property owners

PHASE 03

LATE SUMMER: Final Recommendation

- Determine what, if any, traffic calming measures will be recommended
- Determine recommended location and notify the community

Depending on funding, the City plans to hire a construction contractor in early 2023. Construction is anticipated later in 2023.
